

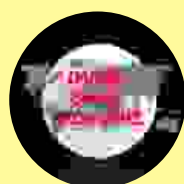

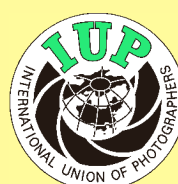

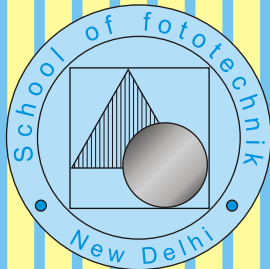

Fototechnik Salon Diplomas:

The School of Fototechnik will award TEN Salon Diplomas to selected top successful Entrants. The selection will be done by the Distinction Committee of the School of Fototechnik on the basis of the Salon Result. The Awardees will be eligible to write the acronyms after their name.

ONE : Fototechnik Crown - **CSoF**

THREE : Fototechnik Ruby - **RSoF**

THREE : Fototechnik Emerald - **ESoF**

THREE : Fototechnik Turquoise - **TSoF**

Conditions of Entry:

2nd KPC International Salon of Photography is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to the exhibition rules and conditions.

An entrant's images will not be presented to the judges consecutively. An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging in that section. Distribution of images shall be in the same round order as submitted by the entrant.

Entries must originate as photographs (image-captures of objects via light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his own (aliases are not permitted). The entrant permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. Note: Entrants who indicate that their images may not be reproduced or used "will not be eligible for awards" or inclusion in audio-visuals of the exhibition "and could be subject to disqualification" by the exhibition sponsors.

The exhibition assumes no liability of any misuse of copyright. Images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker. Artwork or computer graphics created by the entrant may be incorporated provided the photographic content predominates, subject to Nature and Photo Travel divisional restrictions. All final work must be on photographic film, or on electronic file.

No title or identification of the maker shall be visible anywhere on the face of an image entered in a PSA Recognized exhibition.

Each image must have a unique title. Once an image has been accepted in a PSA Recognized exhibition, that same image, or a like "in camera" or a "reproduction" duplicate of that image:

- i. May not be re-entered in any section of the same Division Star Ratings class in that exhibition regardless of media, format, or title.*
- ii. May not be re-titled for entry in any other PSA Recognized exhibition, including translation into another language. Words such as "Untitled" and "No Title" are not acceptable as part or all of an image's title, nor are camera capture filenames.*

BREACH OF CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

If the exhibition determines before, during, or after the judging that an entrant has submitted entries where one or more images fail to comply with these Conditions of Entry, including the stated definitions, the exhibition reserves the right and discretion to delete the entry from the exhibition and void any or all acceptances or awards. Fees may be forfeited in these circumstances.

In order to ensure that images comply with the Conditions of Entry and definitions, the exhibition may carry out checks on the images to make sure that:

- a) the images are the original work of the entrant and
- b) the images comply with the rules and definitions as set out in these Conditions of Entry.

This may involve asking the entrant to provide originally captured image(s), with EXIF data intact, by a set deadline. The questioned image(s) of any entrant failing to comply with such a request for the original image(s) may be considered in breach of these Conditions of Entry, and declined. Such entries may be referred to PSA for further investigation of possible ethics violations. PSA retains the right to investigate in any way all complaints/suspicions of breaches of entry conditions, impose sanctions if deemed necessary, void the acceptances of any image found to violate the PSA rules, include the entrant's name on the list of sanctions provided to Exhibitions, and share such investigations with FIAP. Entrants automatically agree to these terms by the act of entering the Exhibition.

Persons who are found guilty of plagiarism are liable to be sanctioned for life.

Each entrant may submit 4 digital images in each section.

Decision of judges will be final and no further claims or protests will be entertained.

Requirement for Digital Files: The image files must be in sRGB colour profile and in JPEG format. Maximum image size (including any borders) should be 1024px horizontal and 768px vertical at 300dpi, saved in maximum level 10 -12. File size should not exceed 1.5 Mb. Entries by online submission only, directly through our website <http://kriti.fototechnik.in>.

Entries will not be accepted in CD or e-mail.

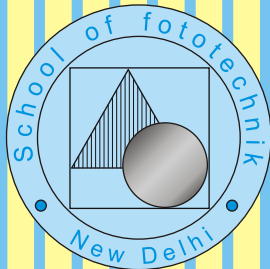
File Names: File name must be the title of the image.

The images will be projected both while judging and public showings in the same resolution of XGA (1024px X 768px) .

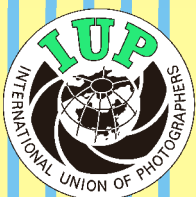

In the Colour Section (PID Color section) Monochrome images must NOT be entered. Monochrome images must be entered in the Monochrome Section and will count towards PID Monochrome Class stars.

Color and monochrome versions of same image, regardless of title, must not be entered in both color class and monochrome class sections.

Acceptances in PID recognized Color sections shall be credited towards PID Color Star Ratings and Who's Who Color listings.

Acceptances in PID recognized Monochrome sections shall be credited towards PID Monochrome Star Ratings and Who's Who Monochrome listings.

All acceptance eligibility shall be in accordance with the PID Star Ratings or the Galaxy/Diamond Ratings requirements as appropriate.

An image that was accepted in a prior CPID recognized section of this exhibition may not be entered in a PID recognized Color section of this exhibition.

All acceptances will count for "PSA Star Ratings and ROPA AWARDS"

All acceptances will count for "AIP Honor Distinctions"

All acceptances will count for "IUP Honor List" and "IUP Distinctions"

All acceptances will count for "ICS Honor and Distinctions"

All acceptances will count for "ISF Honor and Distinctions"

Definitions:

Definitions of Monochrome:

An image is considered to be Monochrome only if it gives the impression of having no colour (i.e. contains only shades of gray which can include pure black and pure white) OR it gives the impression of being a greyscale image that has been toned in one colour across the entire image. (For example by Sepia, red, gold, etc.) A greyscale or multi-coloured image modified or giving the impression of having been modified by partial toning, multi-toning or by the inclusion of spot colouring does not meet the definition of monochrome and shall be classified as a Colour Work.

Definition for Nature:

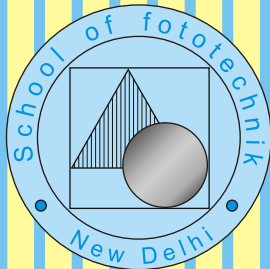
Nature photography is restricted to the use of the photographic process to depict all branches of natural history, except anthropology and archaeology, in such a fashion that a well-informed person will be able to identify the subject material and certify its honest presentation.

The story telling value of a photograph must be weighed more than the pictorial quality while maintaining high technical quality.

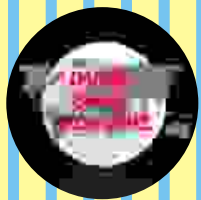
Human elements shall not be present, except where those human elements are integral parts of the nature story such as nature subjects, like barn owls or storks, adapted to an environment modified by humans, or where those human elements are in situations depicting natural forces, like hurricanes or tidal waves.

Scientific bands, scientific tags or radio collars on wild animals are permissible. Photographs of human created hybrid plants, cultivated plants, feral animals, domestic animals, or mounted specimens are ineligible, as is any form of manipulation that alters the truth of the photographic statement.

No techniques that add, relocate, replace, or remove pictorial elements except by cropping are permitted.

Techniques that enhance the presentation of the photograph without changing the nature story or the pictorial content, or without altering the content of the original scene, are permitted including HDR, focus stacking and dodging/burning.

Techniques that remove elements added by the camera, such as dust spots, digital noise, and film scratches, are allowed. *Stitched images are not permitted.* All images must appear natural. Colour images can be converted to greyscale monochrome. *Infrared images, either direct-captures or derivations, are not allowed.*

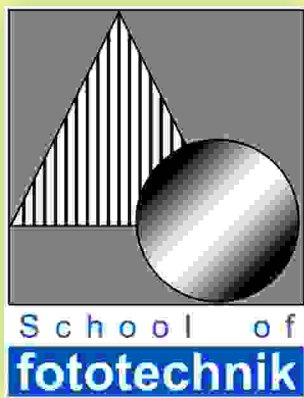
Images entered in Nature sections meeting the *Nature Photography Definition* above can have landscapes, geologic formations, weather phenomena, and extant organisms as the primary subject matter. This includes images taken with subjects in controlled conditions, such as zoos, game farms, botanical gardens, aquariums and any enclosure where the subjects are totally dependent on man for food.

Definition of Photo Travel:

A Photo Travel image expresses the characteristic features or culture of a land as they are found naturally. There are no geographic limitations. Images from events or activities arranged specifically for photography, or of subjects directed or hired for photography are not appropriate. Close up pictures of people or objects must include features that provide information about the environment.

Techniques that add, relocate, replace or remove any element of the original image, except by cropping, are not permitted. The only allowable adjustments are removal of dust or digital noise, restoration of the appearance of the original scene, and complete conversion to greyscale monochrome. Other derivations, including infrared, are not permitted. All allowed adjustments must appear natural.
